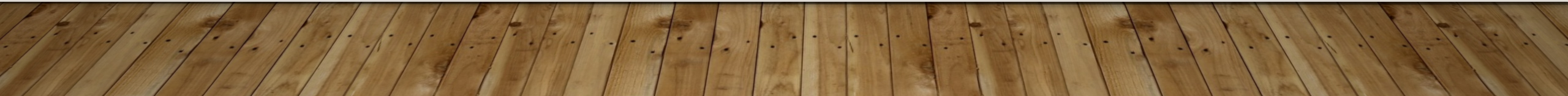

(left) Two skeins on the left are Superwash Merino with Stellina sparkle in colorways Grapevine and Enchanted. Skein on the right is Merino, Yak and Silk in color way Arizona.

(below) Skein on the left has gold Stellina and the skein on the right has silver Stellina.

I'm in the middle of a Find Your Fade shawl using some handspun merino silk from Ashland Bay.

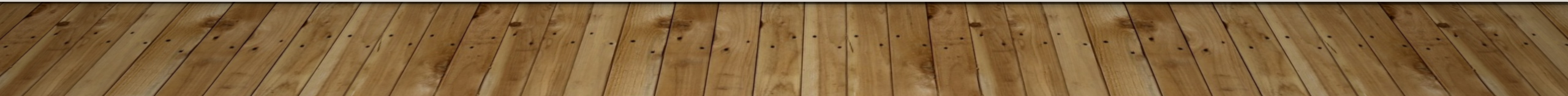
The color way on the left is Mackenzie (a mix of tartan colors that muddied up to a green gray). The color on the right is Jamaica (a mix of very bright hues that muddied up to a pink gray).

The skeins don't match at all, but the tweed yarns blend nicely from one color way to the other. I can't wait to see the finished shawl.

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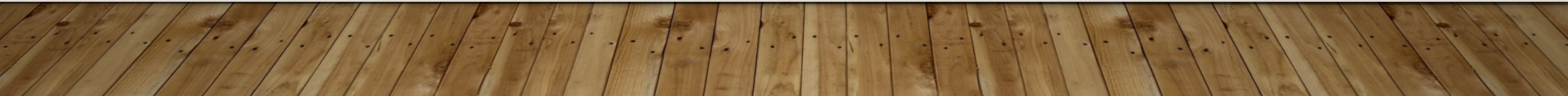

- I altered size and colors



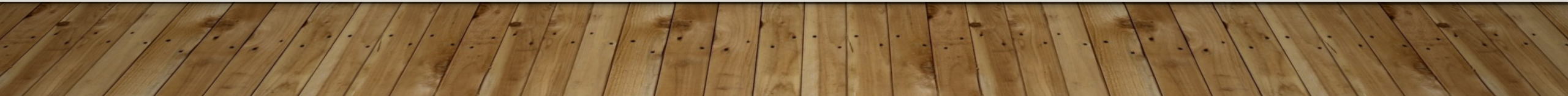
# NANCY REACH

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- Warp is 22/2 bleached cottloin with a sett of 20
- Tabby weft for top one is white 20/2 cotton
- Tabby weft for bottom one is 10/2 UKI cotton
- Original draft was by Linda Adamson in Handwoven in Jan/ Feb 2015
- Picture on right is the same two blankets, photographed under different light.

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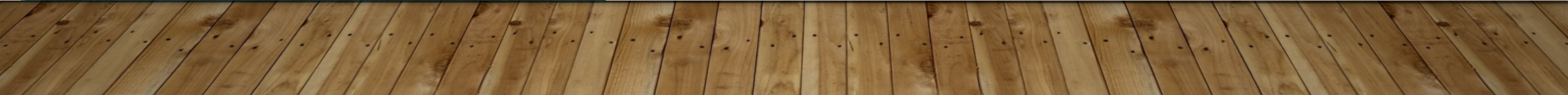
